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Stamping With Renee



MATERIALS:

Cardstock: Basic White, Sahara Sand, Crumb Cake, Evening Evergreen,

Soft Succulent, Misty Moonlight, Early Espresso

Inks: Sahara Sand, Misty Moonlight, Evening Evergreen, Pale Papaya

Stamps: On the Horizon, Hats Off, Dies: Horizon Dies, Hat Builder Dies

Embossing Folder: none

Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine for die cutting

ETC.: Stampin' Write marker in Sahara Sand, Stampin' Dimensionals,

Multi-Purpose Glue

CONSTRUCTION:

1. Card Base: 5 1/2" x8" scored at 4 1/2" in Crumb Cake CS.

- 2. Cut one 4" x 5 1/4" panel of Sahara Sand CS and one 3 3/4" x 5" panel of Basic White CS. Cut one 4" x 5 1/4" panel of Basic White for inside the card.
- 3. Adhere the Sahara Sand panel to front of card base. On the white 3 3/4" x 5" white panel stamp the mountains in Misty Moonlight (I stamped off once, so that the color was more subtle). Stamp the tree background in Evening Evergreen. Use a marker to color in the open white areas at the base of the mountains with Sahara Sand for a shaded effect.
- 4. Stamp the sentiment in Evening Evergreen.
- 5. Stamp and cut a mask from the mountains, then use the mask to stamp the sun (or is it a moon???) in Pale Papaya.
- 6. Cut the intricate trees from Evening Evergreen and Soft Succulent and adhere with dimensionals.
- 7. From the Hats Off set and Hat Builder dies, stamp a hat label of your choice on Sahara Sand and die cut. Stamp Misty Moonlight on Misty Moonlight CS for the hat and die cut. Attach with both multi-purpose glue and dimensionals to achieve the desired three-dimensional effect. Cut a buffalo from Early Espresso and adhere with multi-purpose glue.
- 8. Stamp a sentiment on the 4" X 5 1/4" white CS, and then adhere to inside of card with multi-purpose glue.

STEP IT UP: You could use linen thread or Pebbles embellishments if you like.
