

# Home & Garden Father's Day Card

## **MATERIALS:**

Cardstock: Basic White, Evening Evergreen, Soft Succulent, Sahara Sand, Crumb Cake, Early Espresso, Highland heather, Gold and Silver Foil CS  
Inks: Tuxedo Black Memento, Sahara Sand, Soft Succulent, Evening Evergreen, Early Espresso, So Saffron, Flirty Flamingo, Cajun Craze, Old Olive, Gorgeous Grape

Stampin' Write Markers: Cajun Craze, Old Olive, So Saffron

Stamps: Home & Garden bundle, Flowering Rainboots bundle, and Plentiful Plants bundle

Dies: above

Embossing Folder: Brick and Mortar 3D

Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine  
ETC.: Pebbles Enamel Shapes, Stampin' Dimensionals, Multi-Purpose  
Glue



### CONSTRUCTION:

1. Card Base: Evening Evergreen 4 1/4" x 11" scored at 2 3/4" and 5 1/2."
2. Cut two 4" x 2 1/2" and one 4" x 5 1/4" panel of Sahara Sand CS.
3. Emboss each of the three Sahara Sand pieces of CS using the Brick and Mortar 3-D embossing folder.
4. Cut one piece of 1 1/4" x 11" Crumb Cake scored at 2 3/4" x 5 1/2" for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Z-fold that represents the "dirt."
5. Die cuts: Use Basic White to stamp on and cut different pieces (ladder, pots, tools, etc.) or stamp colored CS for pieces—the choice is yours. I cut the boots from Basic White and used Old Olive to color them; then I embossed the entire surface with clear embossing powder to give them a slick appearance. Two pots are cut from Cajun Craze CS (Flowering Rainboots) and the other is Early Espresso stamped onto Sahara Sand

(Plentiful Plants). The rake is white CS stamped in black and colored with Cajun Craze Stampin' Write marker. The clippers are cut from Crumb Cake and Silver Foil CS, as well as the shovel. Greenery was stamped and cut from Soft Succulent and Evening Evergreen from both Flowering Rainboots and Plentiful Plants. The spade and rake are cut from White and Silver Foil CS, then colored with Old Olive marker. Seed packet and gloves stamped on white, then colored with markers. The flowers for the pot on the large panel were stamped from Flowering Rainboots on white in So Saffron and Flirty Flamingo. The purple flowers are stamped from Plentiful Plants using Gorgeous Grape on Highland Heather CS. The tool rack is Early Espresso stamped on Early Espresso CS (I cut three and glued them on top of each other for depth.). The hooks for the tools are cut from Gold Foil CS.

6. Sentiment: Evening Evergreen stamped on Sahara Sand (Home and Garden) glued to Evening Evergreen background. Adhere with dimensionals.

7. Adhere the Crumb Cake strip to the first panel and the end of the largest (inside) panel. Decide where you would like to adhere all the detailed die-cut pieces along the strip.

8. Adhere two ladders, one at an angle, to the middle panel. Adhere tool rack, hooks, and various tools to the large inside panel.

9. Add Pebble Enamel Shapes wherever you like along the Crumb Cake strip.
