## Oceanfront Masculine Card

## **MATERIALS:**

Cardstock: Basic White, Misty Moonlight, Evening Evergreen, Crumb Cake

Inks: Misty Moonlight, Soft Succulent

Stamps: On the Horizon, Ocean Front, He's All That

Dies: Horizon dies, Ocean Front dies

Embossing Folder: none

Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine for die cuts

ETC.: Horizons DSP, Pebbles Enamel Shapes or Faux Sea Glass

embellishments, Stampin' Dimensionals, Multi-Purpose Glue

## **CONSTRUCTION:**

- 1. Card Base: 4 1/4" x 11" Misty Moonlight scored at 5 1/2" on long side.
- 2. Cut one 3 3/4" x 5" panel of DSP and attach to a 4" x 5 1/4" panel of Evening Evergreen.
- 3. Cut one 2 3/4" x 11" panel of Misty Moonlight scored at 5 1/2" on long side.
- 4. Cut two 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" panels of white CS. Stamp sentiment in Misty Moonlight and grass in Soft Succulent on one, which will be adhered to the DSP layer.
- 5. Stamp the rectangular shape in Misty Moonlight, then use a water brush to "watercolor" the white areas. Cut with die. Cut one piece using gate die from Crumb Cake. Cut grass from Horizons DSP.
- 6. At the top of the other white 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" panel, stamp birds in Misty Moonlight. Attach rectangular shape, fence, and DSP grass. Stamp grass at bottom of panel in Soft Succulent. Stamp "Together for the Long Haul" from He's All That in Misty Moonlight and cut. Adhere between the rectangular shape and the stamped grass at the bottom of panel with dimensionals. Adhere this white panel to the top of the long Misty Moonlight panel.
- 7. Center the Evening Evergreen/Horizons DSP/White sentiment panel vertically to the inside of the long Misty Moonlight panel and adhere. Adhere this long panel to front of original card base. You will end up with two flaps.
- 8. Add Pebble Enamel Shapes or Faux Sea Glass wherever you choose around water and grass area.
