## **MATERIALS:**

Cardstock: Basic White, Mint Macaron, Pale Papaya

Inks: Evening Evergreen Stamps: <u>Sending Smiles</u>

Dies: <u>Bloom Hybrid</u> Embossing Folder Embossing Folder: Bloom Hybrid Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine ETC.: 2021-2023 In Color Opal Rounds, Stampin' Dimensionals, Multi-Purpose Glue

## **CONSTRUCTION:**

- 1. Card Base: 5 1/2" x8" scored at 4 1/2" in Mint Macaron CS
- 2. Cut one 4" x 5 1/4" layer of Pale Papaya; cut one 3 3/4" x 5" piece of white CS, and one 4" x 5 1/4" white CS for inside card.
- 3. Emboss the 3 3/4" x 5" panel using Bloom Hybrid 3D embossing folder and adhere to Pale Papaya panel, and then adhere that to the front of the card base.
- 4. Die cuts:
  - Use the dies from <u>Bloom Hybrid Embossing Folder</u> to cut flowers from the 2021-2023 In Colors Pearlescent Vellum, I used Fresh Freesia, Pale Papaya, and Polished Pink.
  - Use the dies to cut leaves from the vellum in Soft Succulent and Evening Evergreen. I also embossed some of the leaves on vellum before die cutting them for the texture.
- 2. Arrange the flowers on the front white embossed panel and adhere with mini dimensionals. Arrange the leaves how you want them and adhere with multi-purpose glue.
- 3. Use matching 2021-2023 In Color Opal Rounds for the center of each flower.
