## **MATERIALS:**

Cardstock: Crumb Cake, Early Espresso, Evening Evergreen, Soft

Succulent, Basic White, Silver Foil CS

Inks: Evening Evergreen, Night of Navy, Staz-on Black

Stamps: Geared Up Garage (retired)

Dies: Garage Dies (retired), Seasonal Labels, Stitched Rectangles

Embossing Folder: none

Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine for die cutting

ETC.: Old masculine style DSP, Brushed Metallic Adhesive Backed Dots,

Stampin' Dimensionals, Multi-Purpose Glue

## **CONSTRUCTION:**

- 1. Card Base: 5 1/2" x8" scored at 4 1/2" in Crumb Cake CS
- 2. Cut one 4" x 5 1/4" panel of Early Espresso CS and one of white CS (one for front layer and other for inside card).
- 3. Cut four 3/4" x 5" strips of alternating DSP. I used some old retired paper that I found. Attach the four strips to the Early Espresso panel, then attach to the card base.
- 4. Stamp the car onto white CS using Night of Navy ink (I painted the white areas and headlights with metallic watercolors.), and die cut.
- 5. Stamp the toolbox on Silver Foil CS using Staz-on Black ink. Use Garage dies to cut toolbox, tools, and gears in Silver Foil CS. Arrange and adhere gears, car, toolbox, and tools with multi-purpose glue and/or dimensionals.
- 6. Stamp "You're a Classic" on Soft Succulent CS and cut with die from Seasonal Labels.
- 7. Cut a rectangle from Stitched Rectangles die in Evening Evergreen. Glue the sentiment onto the rectangle. Attach rectangle to front of card with dimensionals.
- 8. Stamp a sentiment on the 4" x 5 1/4" panel of white CS, then adhere to inside of card.
